\$1,000 Scholarship: One recipient annually will receive a \$1,000 scholarship. The award will be provided to a graduating high school senior who lives in the City of Springdale, Ohio. The scholarship recipient will have an overall GPA of 3.0 or higher. He or she will share Springdale Offering Supports value of community service and will demonstrate an impressive record of volunteer activity. This is a service oriented scholarship. Funds will be distributed directly to the college, university, or trade school attended by the scholarship recipient.

Name and address of prospective college, university, or trade school:

Immediate family members of any City of Springdale Employee, Elected Official, or Springdale Offering Support Board Member are ineligible for the SOS Scholarship Program. For the purposes of this policy, "immediate family" is defined as the following: parents, children (including step and foster), son-in-law, daughter-in-law, siblings, spouse, grandparents, grandchildren, and legal guardian or other person who stands in the place of a parent.
