RE: COVID-19 Vaccination Clinics

Springdale Health is providing COVID-19 vaccinations through clinics at the Springdale Community Center. We are receiving limited quantities of the vaccine from the Ohio Department of Health and will provide the vaccinations by Ohio's guidelines. Springdale Health is currently working through Ohio's Phase 1A vaccination schedule. Please click the link below to obtain further information from ODH about Phase 1A:

Phase 1B will begin on January 18, 2021. Please follow the link below for additional Phase 1B information:

Phase 1B will specifically include those below who choose to be vaccinated:

- Ohioans, age 65 and up.
- Vulnerable Ohioans with severe congenital, developmental, or early-onset medical disorders.
- Adults/employees in all schools that want to go back, or to remain, educating in person.

Information below outlines the Phase 1B tiered system, which will include roughly 2.2 million eligible Ohioans. Please note that when a new age group begins, vaccinations will likely not be complete for the previous age group. At this time, the number of vaccine doses available is the primary limiting factor:

- Jan. 18th Ohioans 80 years of age and older.
- Jan. 25th Ohioans 75 years of age and older; those with severe congenital or developmental disorders.
- Feb. 1st Ohioans 70 years of age and older
- Feb. 1st Employees of K-12 schools that wish to remain or return to in-person or hybrid models.
- Feb. 8th Ohioans 65 years of age and older.

Springdale residents are encouraged to contact the Springdale Health Department at 513-346-5725 to sign up for our COVID-19 vaccination clinics or to obtain needed additional information. We appreciate your patience and the opportunity to partner with you to serve the Springdale community.
