OLD BUSINESS

Special Needs Assessment Case

At the April 17, 2019 meeting, Amy Ellis, Nurse for the Springdale Health Department had brought forth a special needs assessment regarding a resident. It was in reference to possible assistance for a leaking toilet. It was previously agreed that the plumbing repair of \$125 would be paid by S.O.S. The final repair amount was actually \$175 and was paid by S.O.S. Nurse Ellis stated that the resident was extremely grateful for the assistance.

Euchre Tournament

If a meeting would be necessary in August, members of S.O.S. will be notified. Greg Karle stated that he could print the tickets and will check on lawn signs.
